## RingStor Cloud – DataAgent Auto Update

**RingStor DataAgent auto update enables automatic software update for Windows, Linux and ChromeOS DataAgents.**

**Following are steps to set up auto update:**

**1. Set up a web folder**

A web accessible folder must be created first, for example,

C:\inetpub\wwwroot\RSWeb\rsautoupdate

Write down the URL to this web folder, for example,


<http://www.yourcompany.com/rsautoupdate>

Unzip and copy DataAgent auto update files into this folder. To check if it is setup properly, open the following url from an internet explorer, if xml is displayed properly, auto update has been set up.

**2. Enable auto update for community**

From RingStor Explorer's top menu System -> Community -> Manage Communities, open Property for each community:
